Essential gear

- ☐ backpack or duffle
- ☐ pocketknife & Totin' Chip
- ☐ wristwatch
- ☐ personal first-aid kit (see below)
- ☐ poncho
- ☐ water bottle (1 liter/quart Nalgene)
- ☐ flashlight or headlamp
- ☐ matches and fire starters
- ☐ daypack

Sleeping gear

- ☐ sleeping bag (0° or 20° winter bag)
- ☐ sleeping pad (1" thick or more)
- ☐ ground cloth (optional)
- ☐ extra bag liners
- ☐ extra wool blankets
- ☐ moving pad for under sleeping bag

Clothes

- ☐ NOTE: No Cotton Clothes
- ☐ class A uniform (on the road)
- ☐ Pants (no cotton - no jeans)
- ☐ Shirt
- ☐ Fleece jacket, or sweater
- ☐ Underwear
- ☐ Thermal underwear (heavy type)

- ☐ Wool socks (3 pair)
- ☐ Camp shoes (optional)
- ☐ Parka or cold weather jacket
- ☐ Knit cap or Balaclava
- ☐ Insulated Gloves (2 pair)
- ☐ 2 Bread bags (wet boot liners)
- ☐ Hiking boots (waterproofed)

Toilet kit

- ☐ toothbrush & toothpaste

Eating utensils

- ☐ fork and spoon or spork

Miscellaneous gear
