

Summer Camp Packing List

All clothing and gear must be labeled with the Scout's name

- Footlocker & a lock

Paperwork

- Completed "BSA Medical Forms AB&C"
- Merit badge prerequisite paperwork
- Merit badge pamphlets
- Scout Handbook
- Totin' Chip Card (needs if carrying a knife)

Clothes

- Class A uniform (wear to/from camp and to evening meals)
- Class B Scout tee shirts (Troop 888 or others)
- 2nd pair of uniform shorts
- Socks (at least 7 pair)
- Underwear (6 pair)
- Light weight long pants (for mosquitos)
- Light weight long sleeve shirt (for mosquitos)
- Hiking boots
- Sneakers or light shoes
- Water shoes (if taking lake merit badges)
- Flip flops for shower
- Swim trunks and towel (pack in daypack)
- Pajamas
- Hat with visor
- Jacket, sweatshirt, or sweater

Sleeping

- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Mosquito netting (optional)
- Sheets to cover camp mattress (optional)

Toiletries

- Towel
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Comb/brush
- Finger nail file
- Handkerchief
- Spare toilet paper
- Soap (in a container)
- Deodorant
- Mirror
- Shampoo
- Wash cloth
- Talcum powder

Gear

- CHEAP WRIST WATCH (required)
- Small Daypack
- LED Flashlight (with extra batteries)
- Raincoat or poncho (a MUST)
- Laundry bag
- Pocket knife & Tote N Chip card
- Wallet
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Bug repellent
- Sunglasses
- Rope for clothes line, fixing tent, etc.
- Notepad and pen/pencil
- Personal first aid kit
- Camera (optional)
- Bandana or scout neckerchief (optional)
- Collapsible chair or stool (optional)
- Compass (optional)
- Backpack and tent (if needed for MB)
- Personal cook gear (if needed for MB)
- Long sleeve shirt and slacks (if needed for Swimming and Lifesaving MB)
- Dryer sheets (optional – keep spiders away)
- Small battery powered fan for tent (optional)
- Clothes hanger for uniform (optional)

Miscellaneous

- Personal medications
 - Packed in original container
 - Printed dosage instructions
 - All packed in named zip lock bag
- Spending money for trading post and merit badge supplies

Fishing Gear (optional)

- Fishing rod and reel (in carrier)
- Tackle (don't bring live bait)

Prohibited in Camp

- Firearms or bows
- Sheath knives or 4" knife blades
- Alcoholic beverages
- Fireworks
- Tobacco products
- Cell phone
- Comic books
- Electronic devices
- MP3 players/CD Player/Radio
- Valuables (watches, etc.)
